As a beginner, you will also learn basic wheel skills (centering, opening, pulling, shaping, trimming and finishing), and apply these skills to create basic cylindrical forms. Our small classes are geared toward beginners; although, instruction may be tailored based on interest and skill level. (6 person minimum.)
